Part of what makes visiting *Dolly* of special interest is that she is based at one of the most significant warbird museums in the country in Chino, California. Ed Maloney, the founder of the Planes of Fame Museum, was one of the first to recognize the significance of acquiring, restoring, and preserving the planes that represent our heritage. To showcase their collection they join forces with other warbird collectors for one of the best areal displays of our flying history. Surrounded by these great planes, it will be a terrific place to combine our reunion with their air show.

The 506th Fighter Group will be joined by a few other veteran groups being honored as guests at this air show. We will be using our own vans to travel from the hotel to the Chino airport. There will be a large canopy under which some group may wish to casually review the activities. Each evening of the reunion we will be having a meal at the hotel and plenty of time to retell our adventures of years gone by.

In case a flight in a warbird is of interest, it is common practice at shows like this to sell rides the day before the show. Check the Planes of Fame web site for availability, and make a reservation. There may be some new Mustang pilots by the time our reunion is over. This is a reunion not to be missed.
